Our kids are loving the new apartment and adjusting well.

Last prayer letter we mentioned a situation concerning the plumbing issue we encountered with the new church building. This has finally been resolved. The owner agreed to pay for half of the expenses. Praise the Lord we have not had any other issues and we thank you again for helping us pray and give toward that need.

We have had several new visitors come to our Bible studies. One of them is our neighbor, who agreed to come with us at least once a month, but has been coming more often. She seems interested and we are hopeful she will soon get saved. We have shared the gospel with the other visitors that have come and we are praying for their salvation. Another lady contacted us last week about starting discipleship after seeing our sign, so we will begin that shortly. We are still discipling those that were saved recently and continue to see God working in their lives. Keep praying that those who are saved would understand the importance of church attendance and would be faithful to God.

We want to thank you from the bottom of our hearts for praying for my dad while he was hospitalized due to Covid. He is recovering very well! Although he doesn't feel 100% yet, he has improved tremendously already. Now, if you could please pray for my mother-in-law. She was recently diagnosed with CML (Chronic Myeloid Leukemia).
